The modern exterior melts away the moment you step beneath the lobby's breathtaking leaded glass laylight—a historical masterpiece that bathes the space in a warm, timeless glow.

Inspired by Les Salles Rouges at the Louvre, this monumental 45-foot by 12-foot installation seamlessly merges 19th-century romance with modern innovation.

Each of the forty-five individual panels was hand-crafted by local artisans, then backlit by cutting-edge, color-adjustable LED technology to perfectly diffuse the light.

Anchoring this stunning canvas is a grand central chandelier, casting an aura of pure elegance over the entire room.



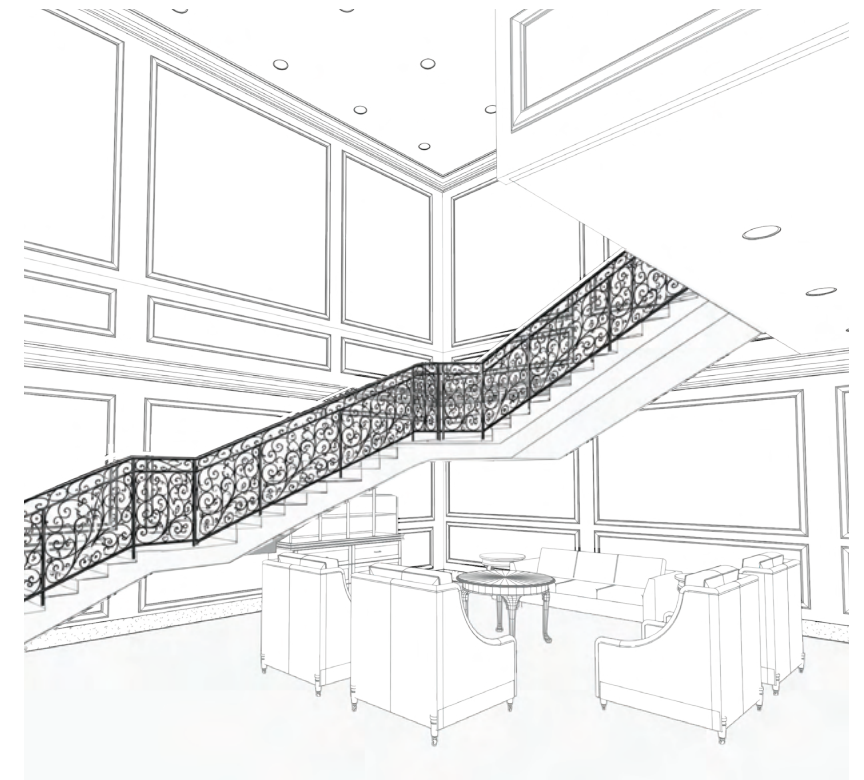

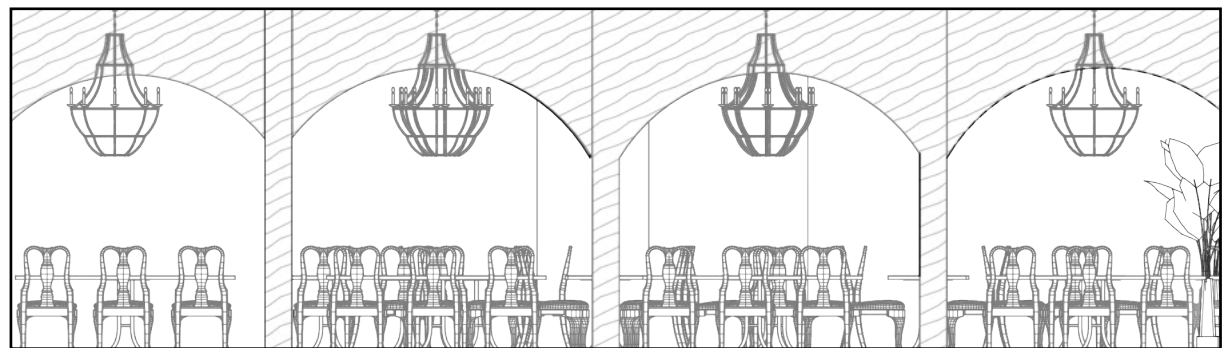

Completed by rich travertine floors and classic French furnishings, this room is a masterclass in romance and refinement.



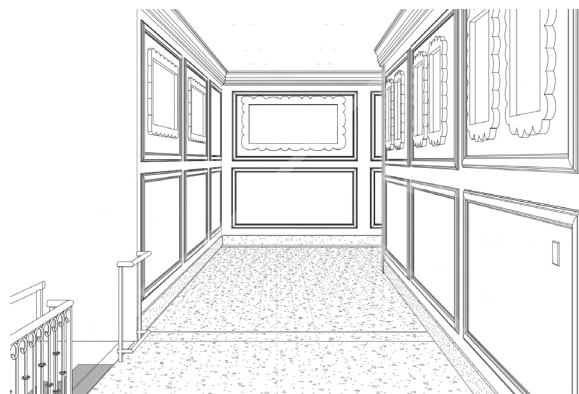

Every design choice honors the worlds Tolkien created while celebrating the world he cherished most: his family.

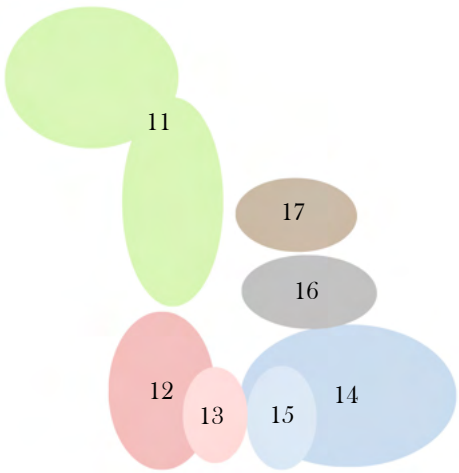

A PRIVATE RETREAT

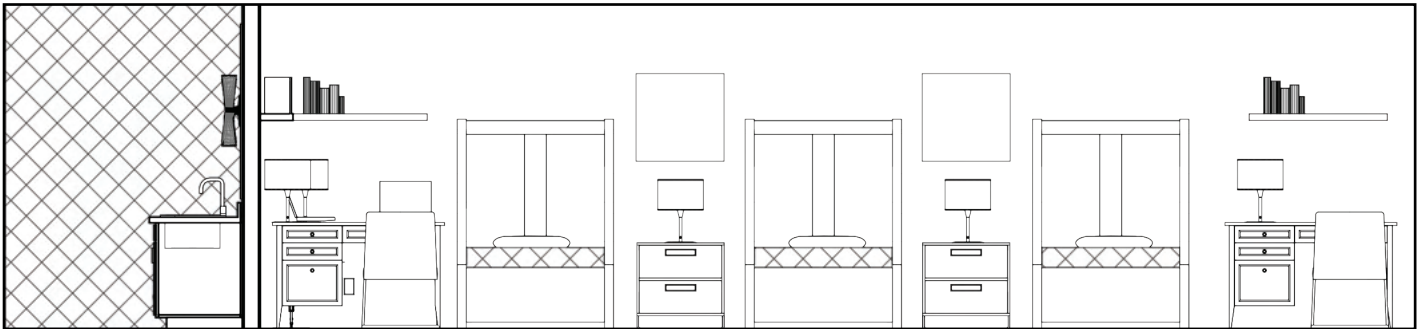
A private sanctuary shaped for quiet restoration, the Primary Suite opens with a wall of arched windows that highlight the very view that first drew them here.

The bath evokes a deep-woods retreat, wrapped in calming hues and organic textures that blur the line between architecture and nature. Integrated closet cupboards keep the space serene and uncluttered, allowing daily rituals to unfold in privacy.

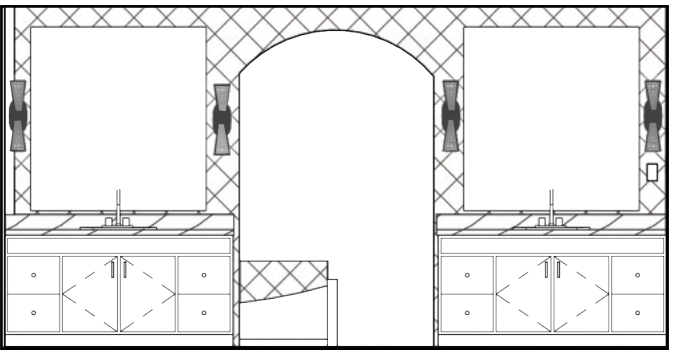
A two-person shower, washed in natural light through privacy glass, and a discreet water closet complete this haven of quiet luxury.

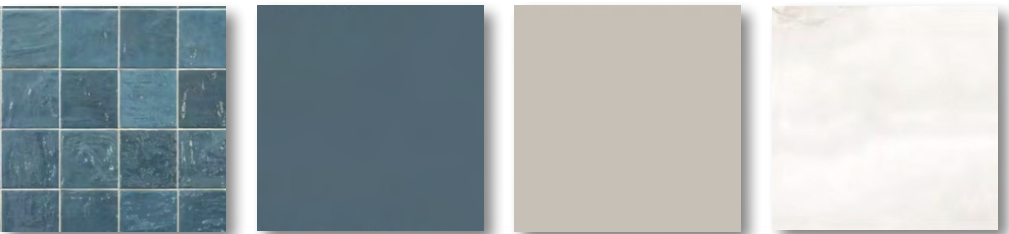

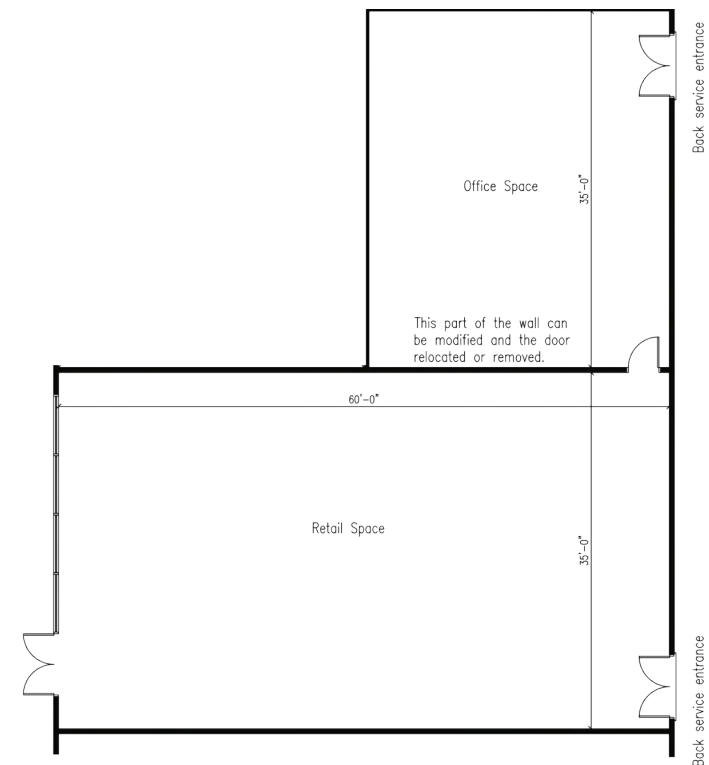
THE BROTHERS' HIDEOUT

Designed in a modern dorm-style layout, this suite gives each of the three brothers a thoughtful balance of privacy and togetherness. A spacious walk-in closet provides a dedicated storage wall for each child, while the bathroom features three individual vanities and a private water closet.

A cozy lounge anchors the shared space, complemented by three separate study nooks that support focus and independence. It's a suite created for growing up side-by-side: a place for late-night talks, big ideas, and the kind of memories only brothers can make.

THE EASTSIDE PASSAGE- YORKE ATELIER

A high-end men's boutique with deep New York roots is bringing its signature style to Salt Lake City, and it refuses to arrive quietly. The vision: a space that feels like a discovery, a hidden world tucked behind an unassuming threshold. Step inside, and you're transported to an Upper East Side streetscape, complete with the architectural romance and refined energy that define Manhattan's most iconic neighborhood.

More than a store, *York Atelier* is crafted as a destination: a backdrop for events, a magnet for digital media creators, and a place where fashion and atmosphere collide. It's the kind of space that becomes the talk of the town; not just for what it sells, but for the world it invites you into.

THE EASTSIDE PASSAGE



NORTH WALL

A rich brick backdrop anchors a dramatic brownstone-style stucco façade. Frosted, backlit windows cast a soft glow, while sculpted window boxes add depth and quiet theatricality. Behind the three distinctly different doors is a completely private dressing room, lit with warm, refined illumination. Deep green velvet curtains frame a 16-foot backlit frosted window, creating a luminous focal point that highlights impeccably styled mannequins.



SOUTH WALL

Two expansive loft-style windows frame a balcony display, where iron railings showcase three mannequins. A fire-escape ladder draws the eye downward to the concrete steps, creating a natural stage for featured merchandise. Walnut shelving and tailored hanging racks line the façade. A polished brass sign highlights the store’s brand, while a floral window box and classic street lamp complete the immersive streetscape.



EAST WALL

Crafted as a cinematic backdrop for content creators, the space transforms into an experience through the layered interplay of brick, stucco, and refined architectural detailing. Café tables provide a comfortable place for guests to relax while shoppers try on clothing and prepare to step onto the boutique’s own “runway.”



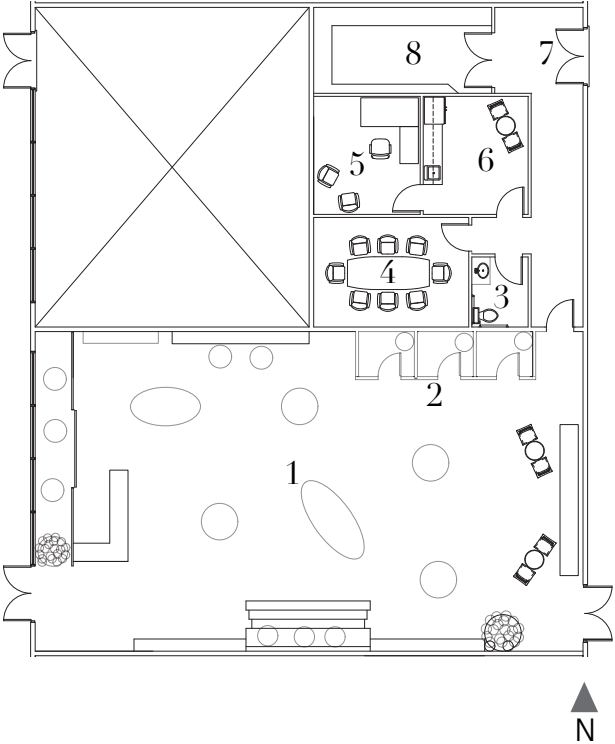
WEST WALL

Guests enter through double walnut doors and are welcomed by an antique streetlamp and the clerk at a paneled walnut checkout counter, warmly illuminated by oversized pendant lanterns. Behind the counter, 16-foot opaque sliding glass doors provide access to the front window display while discreetly blocking the street view, allowing customers to feel fully immersed in the world of Yorke.

A space this memorable is sure to have customers “start spreadin’ the news.”



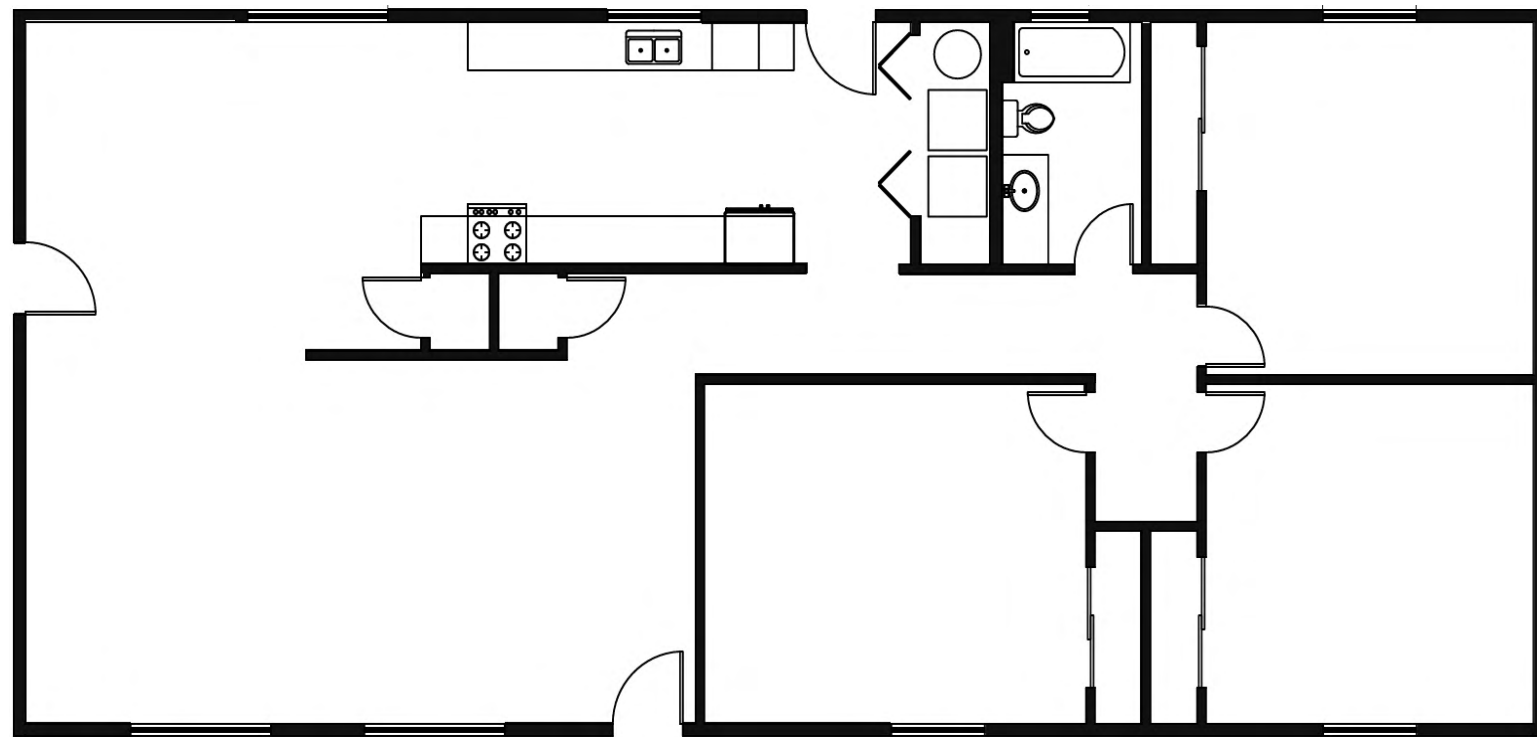
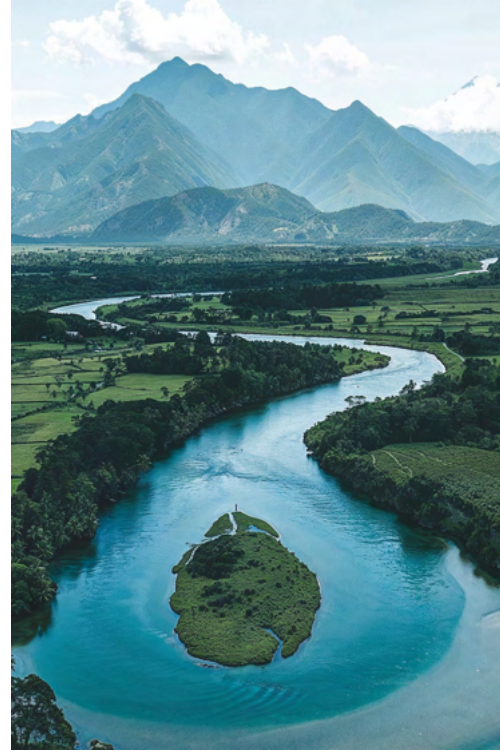

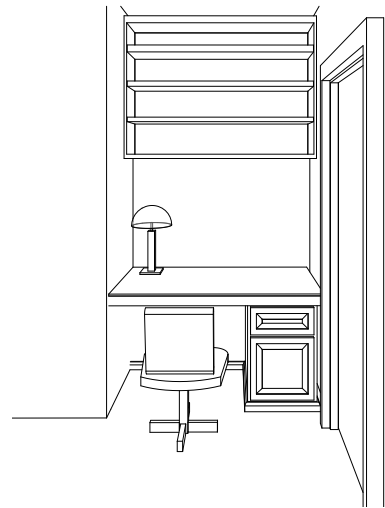
RURAL REIMAGINED

The main living areas were opened to create a seamless, social floor plan anchored by wide-plank white oak flooring. A nature-inspired palette in the living room strengthens the connection between indoors and out.

The dining area features generous wheelchair clearance, a built-in banquette beneath a picture window, and a cloud-shaped chandelier that adds warmth and visual interest.

Low-pile carpeting in the bedrooms provides comfort while supporting ease of mobility, creating spaces that are both functional and restful.

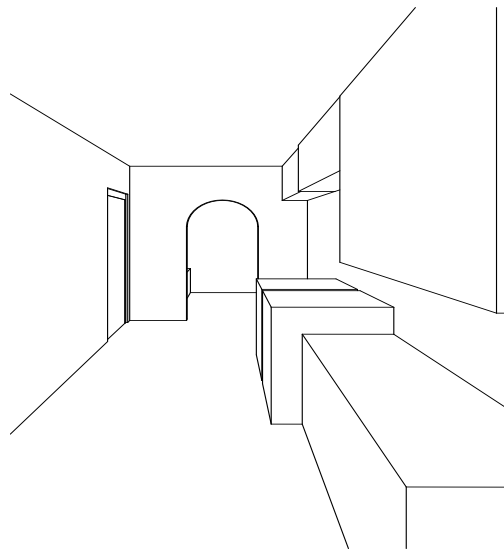

THE CHILDREN'S NOOK

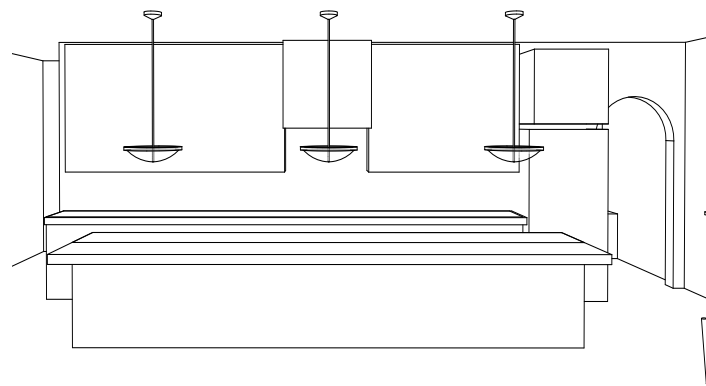
A wheelchair-friendly turning radius sparked something unexpectedly sweet; a tiny nook tucked at the end of the hall just for the kids. What started as pure function became a bright little spot for studying, crafting, and quiet projects, with built-ins that keep everything neatly stashed and the space entirely their own.



MUD/LAUNDRY/WORK-FROM-HOME

THE SERVICE LOOP ANNEX

On the reverse side of the kitchen wall, a hard-working utility zone unfolds; an integrated mudroom, laundry, and built-in desk tucked just beyond the home's main bustle. The space becomes a cozy, efficient work area, offering an easy step into the pantry for a quick snack or an easy stroll toward the gathering room.



KITCHEN WALL

THE ROUNDABOUT KITCHEN

The kitchen's layout moves like a quiet loop, built for easy reach and smooth flow. Lower counters, reachable appliances, and wide, open pathways make the space fully workable from any height. Bar seating anchors the center, while two passages; one leading through the pantry to the mud room and garage, the other opening straight to the mud room; create a gentle circle that keeps kids moving and supports effortless wheelchair access.

A RESTFUL RETREAT

Three expansive windows in the Primary Suite bring the landscape into the room, while low-pile carpet makes moving through the suite effortless.

A roll-under desk with clear knee space, reachable shelving, and intuitive storage offers a comfortable spot to work or unwind.

The Ensuite becomes a serene escape: thoughtfully designed, with a generous roll-in shower, elegant gold grab bars and adjustable showerheads, dual-height vanities, and a roll-under sink designed for easy access. Well considered details: ample turning space, lever hardware, and lowered controls, support independence while keeping the architecture clean and refined.
