Problem

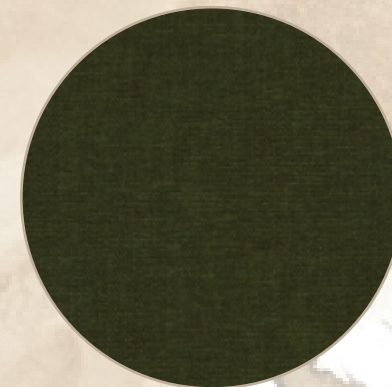
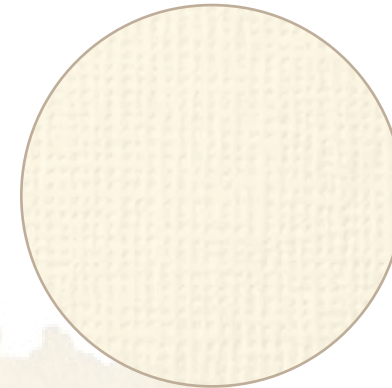

Problem

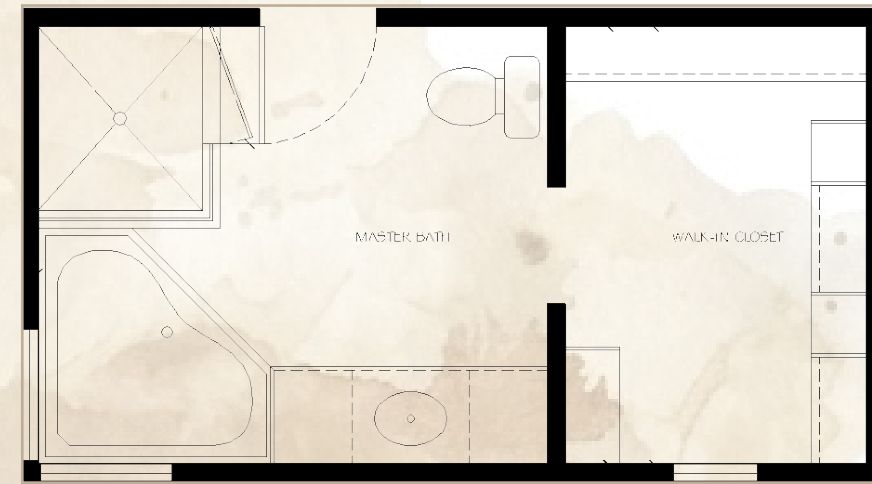

A spa-inspired Tuscan retreat that promotes independence, entertainment, relaxation, and everyday functionality.

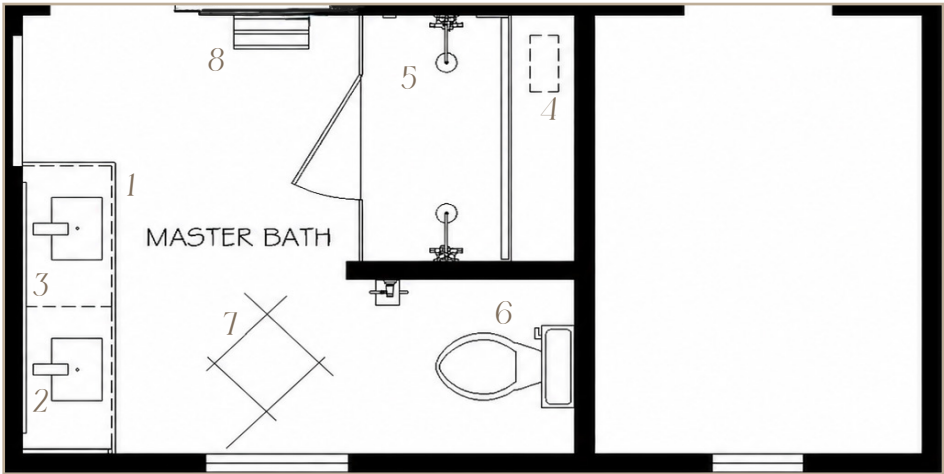


Existing Floor Plan



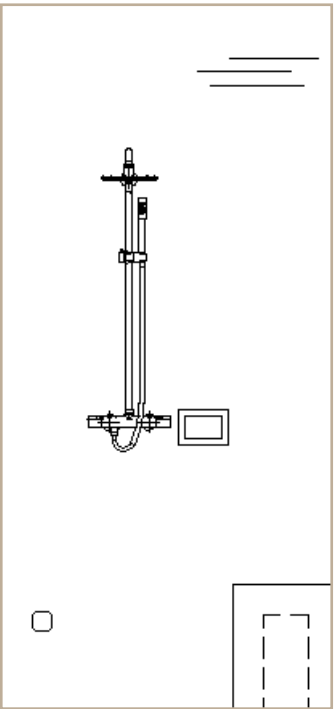
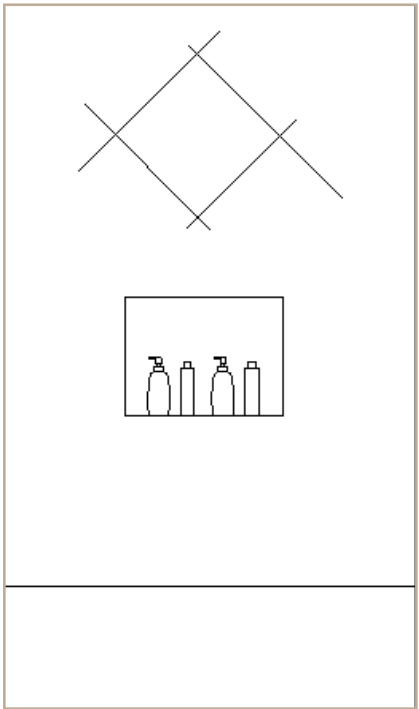
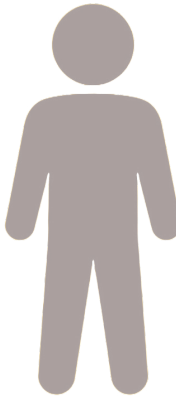
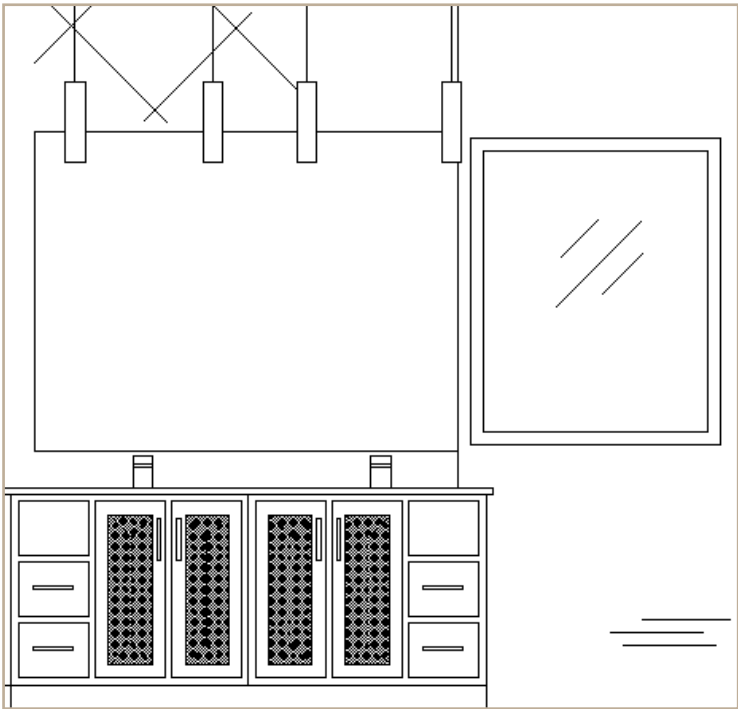
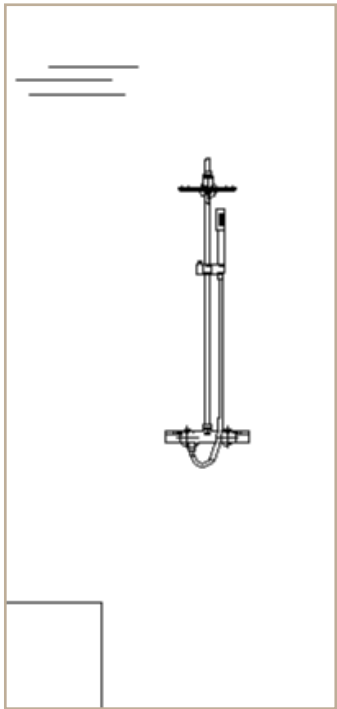
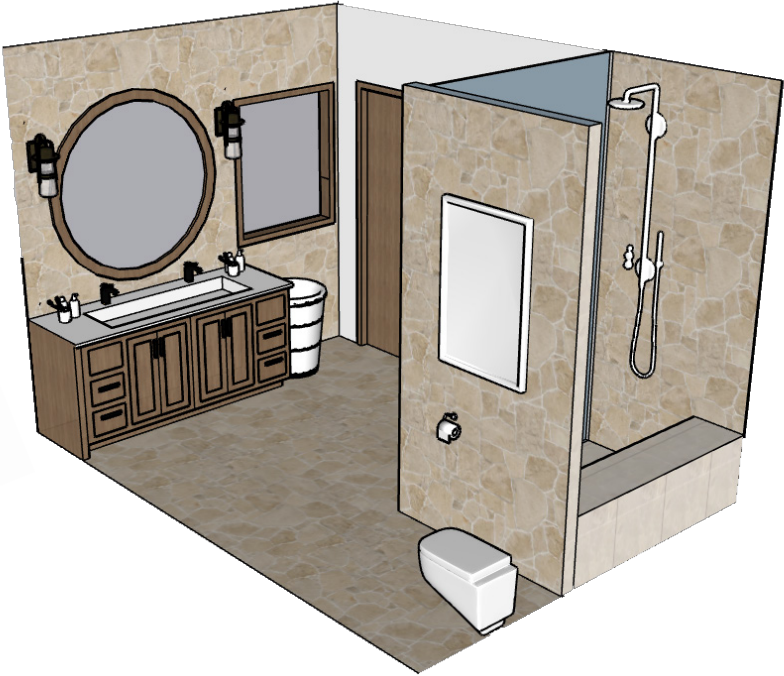

A functional and inviting home that balances comfort, efficiency, and visual harmony.

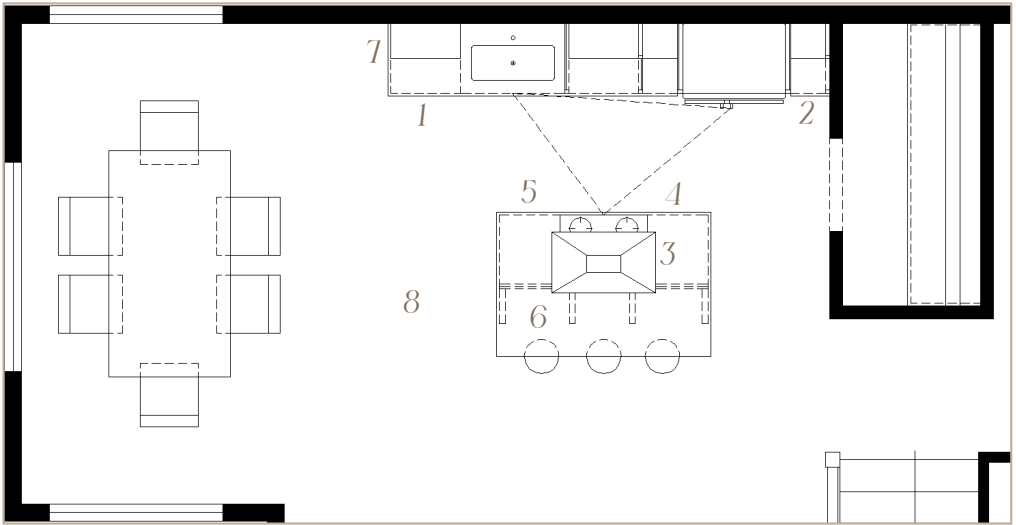


Existing Floor Plan



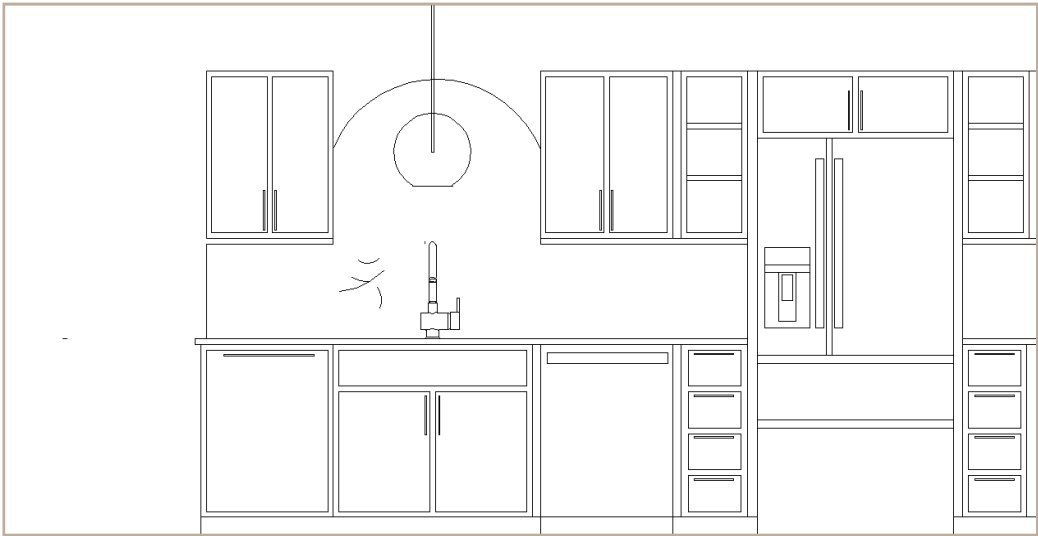

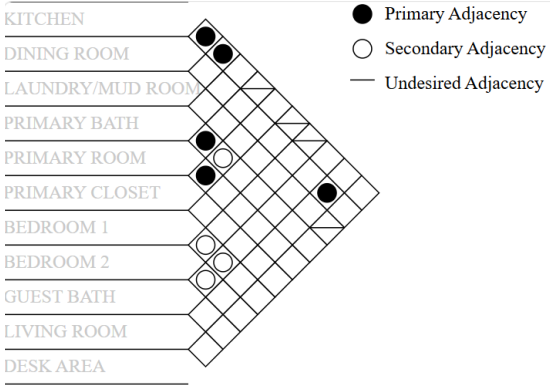
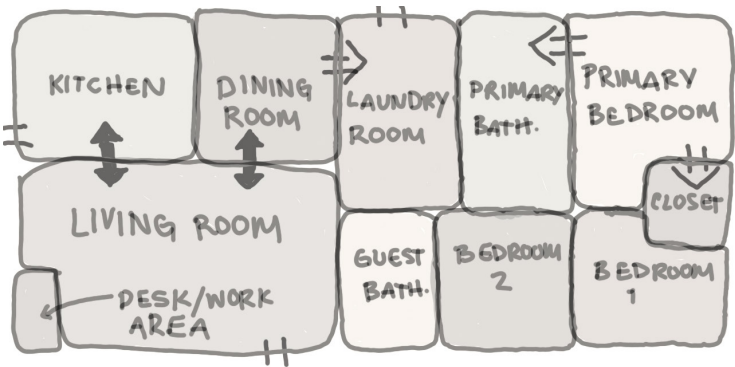


Existing Floor Plan

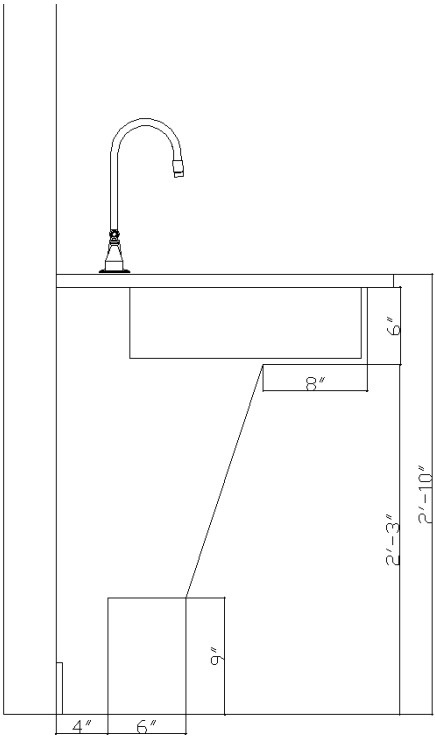

Problem

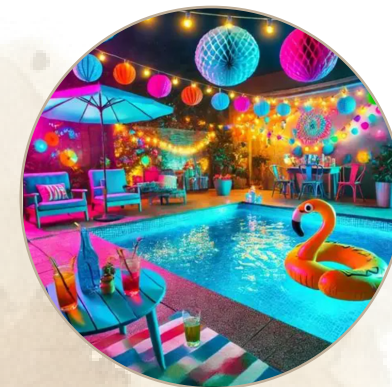

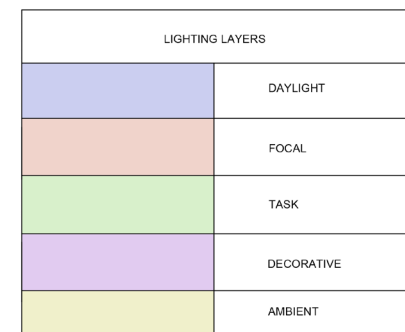
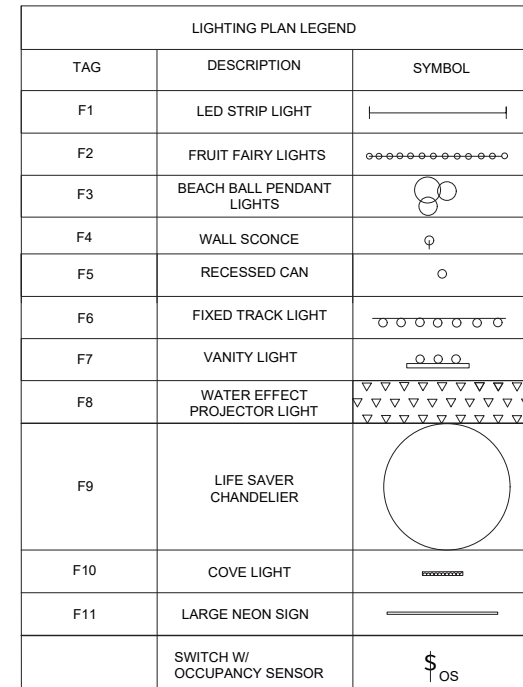
Research

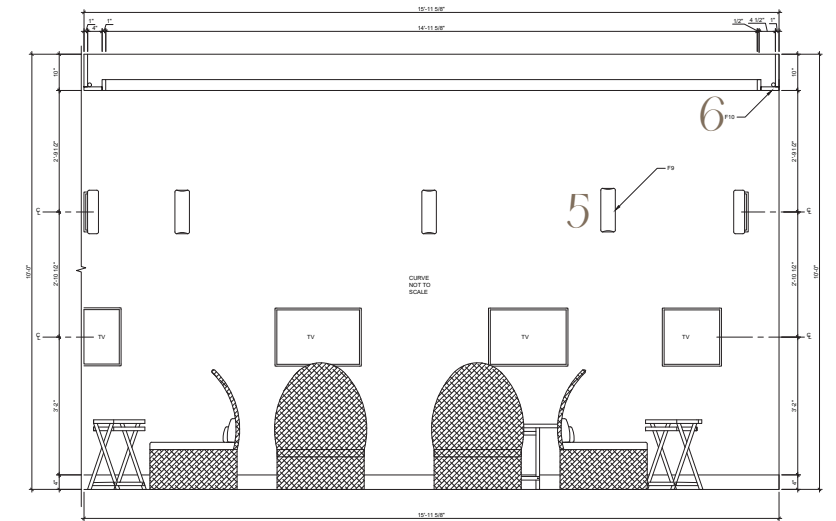
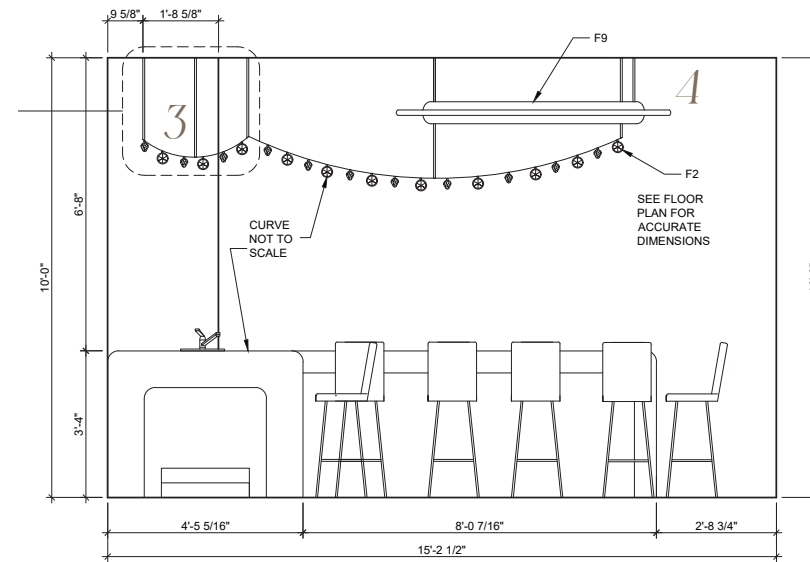
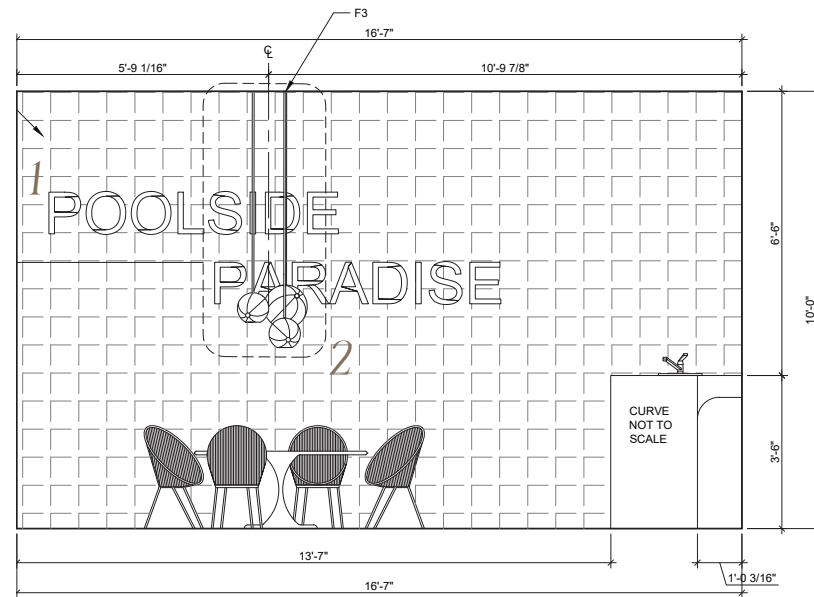
Research examined hospitality lighting, lighting heirarchy, and the influence of lighting on user comfort and engagement.

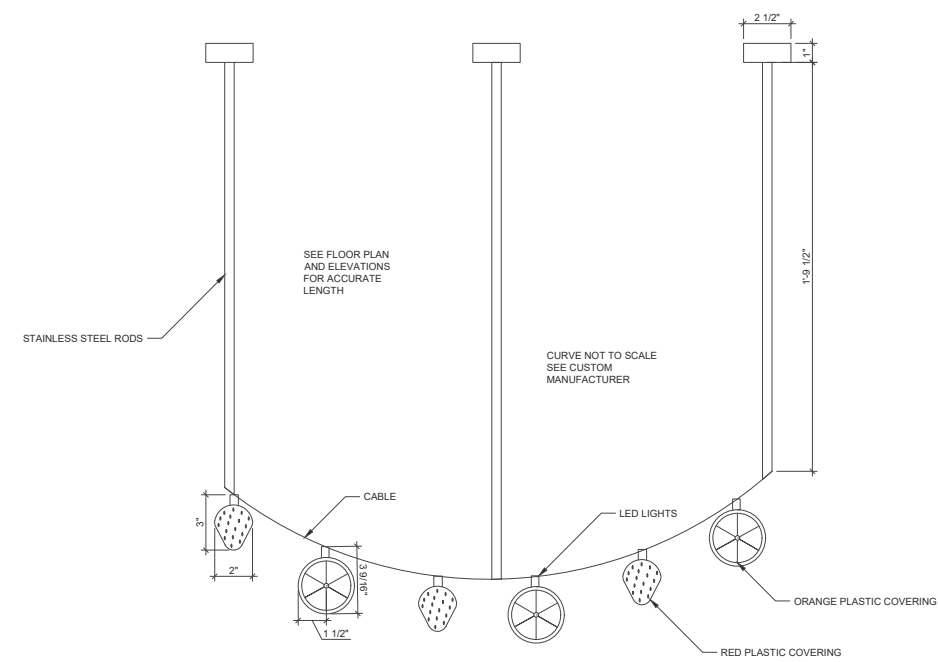

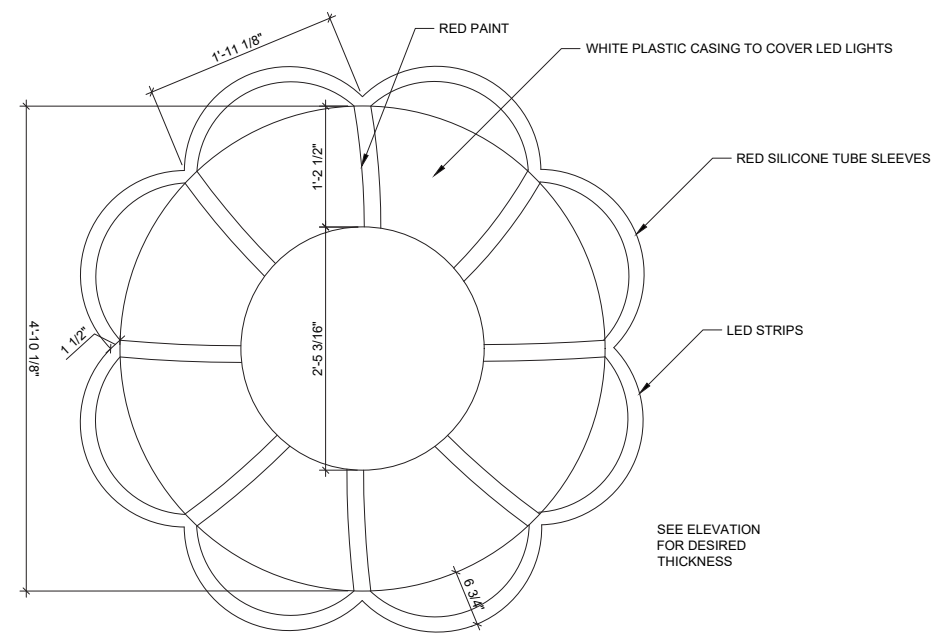
