




Fern Interior Designs

Inspired by the flow of a park— this office is organic, inviting, and designed for both movement and connection.





1/4" = 1'-0" 7 AMPITHEATER - SOUTH VIEW 1/4" = 1'-0"


























The Pond

2 CAROUSEL - EAST VIEW 1/4" = 1'-0" RESIN DIVIDER












3 CAROUSEL - WEST VIEW 1/4" = 1'-0"







Drawing inspiration from the New York City High Line, the design incorporates architectural agriculture with mountain-shaped planters that flow from the exterior into the home, blurring the boundaries between indoors and outdoors. The use of natural light, achieved through skylights, large windows, and interior glass walls, transforms the space into a warm, open retreat. Additionally, the careful division of private and public space ensures functionality for both short-term and longterm rental needs.
