Inspired by the works of Agatha Christie, this hotel was created to feel luxurious and vintage.

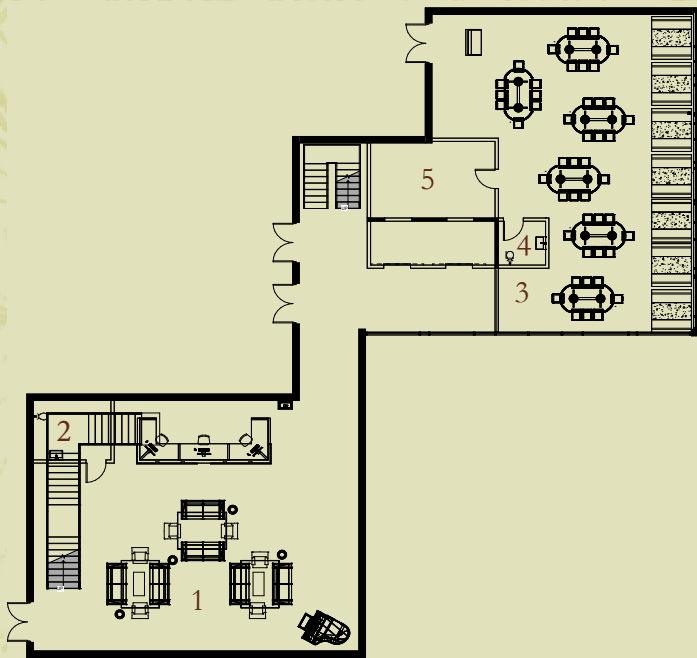

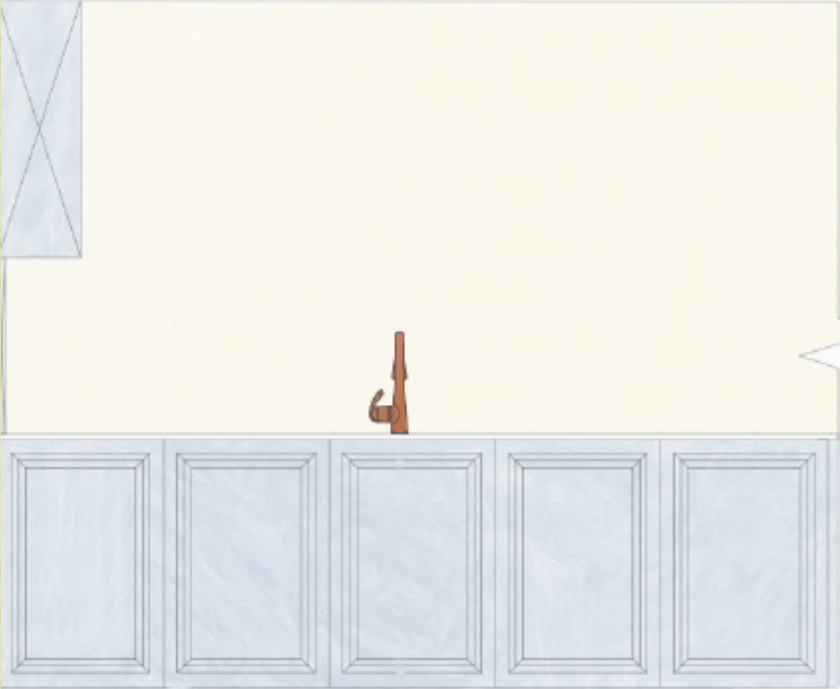

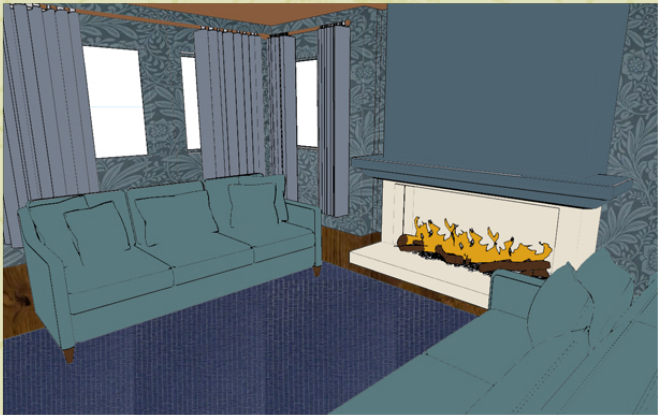

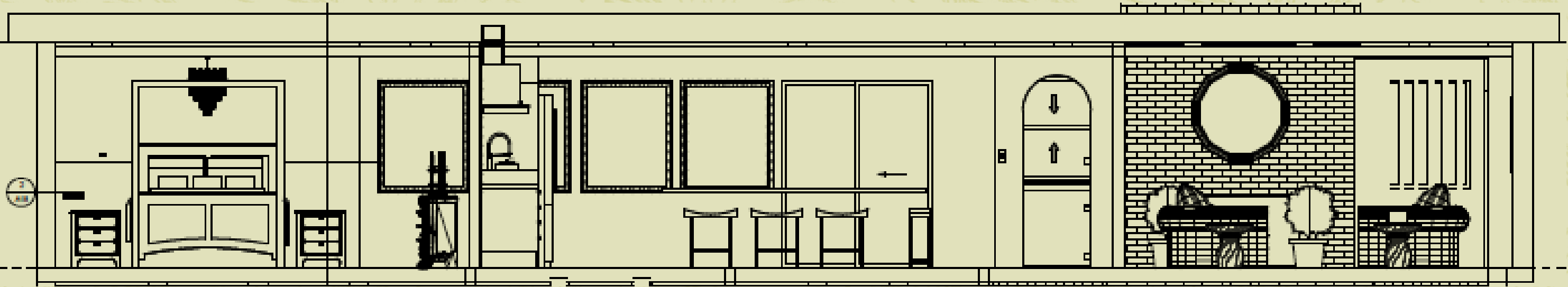

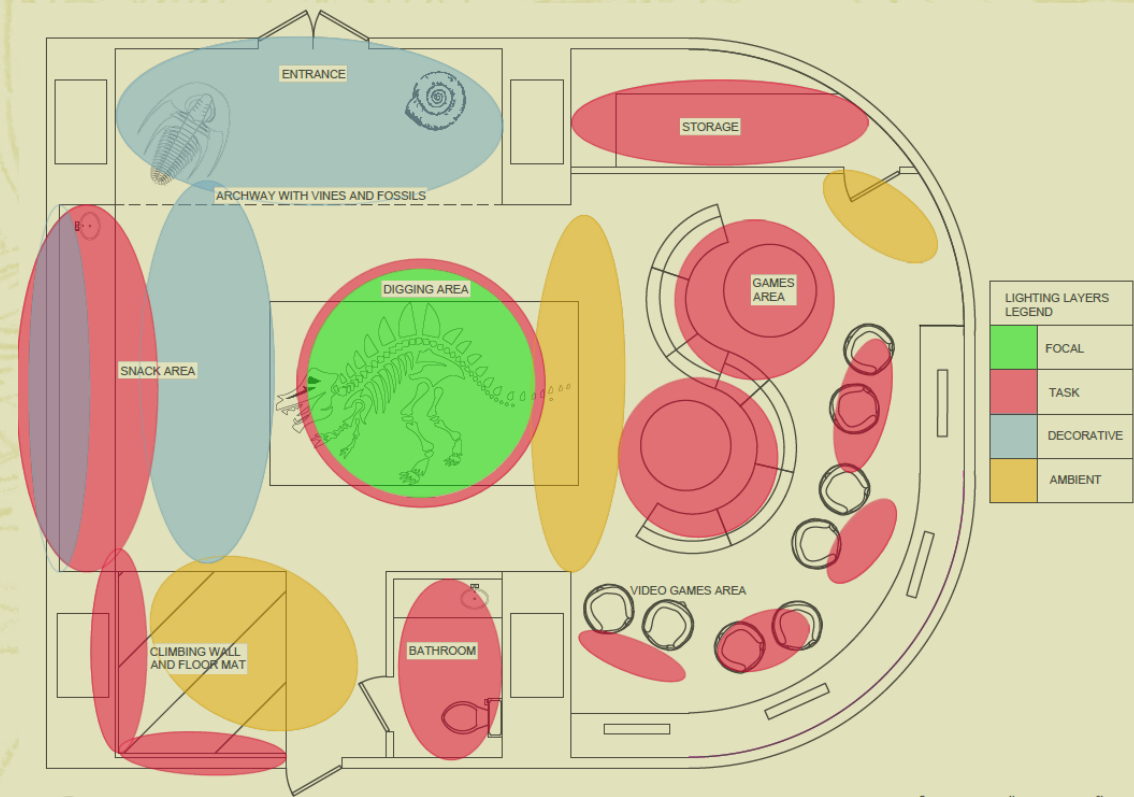


Writing Room & Master Bathroom Rendered in SketchUp

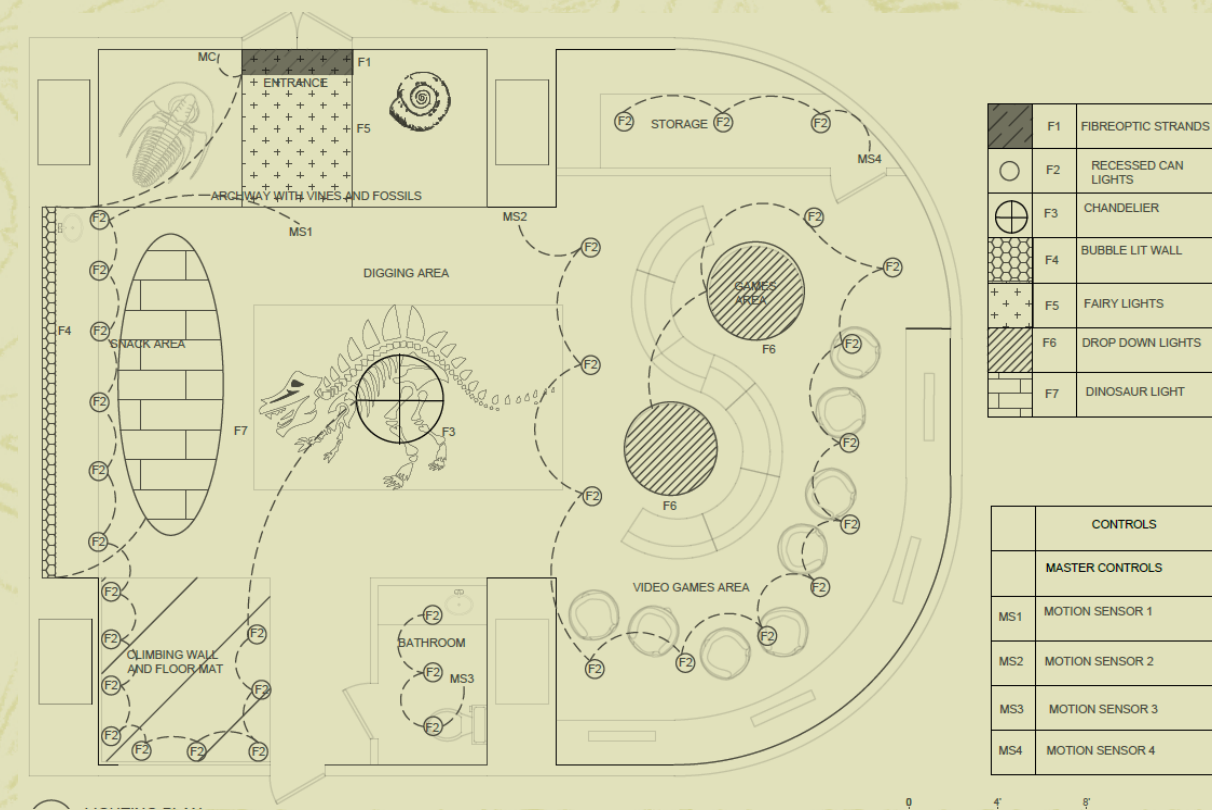

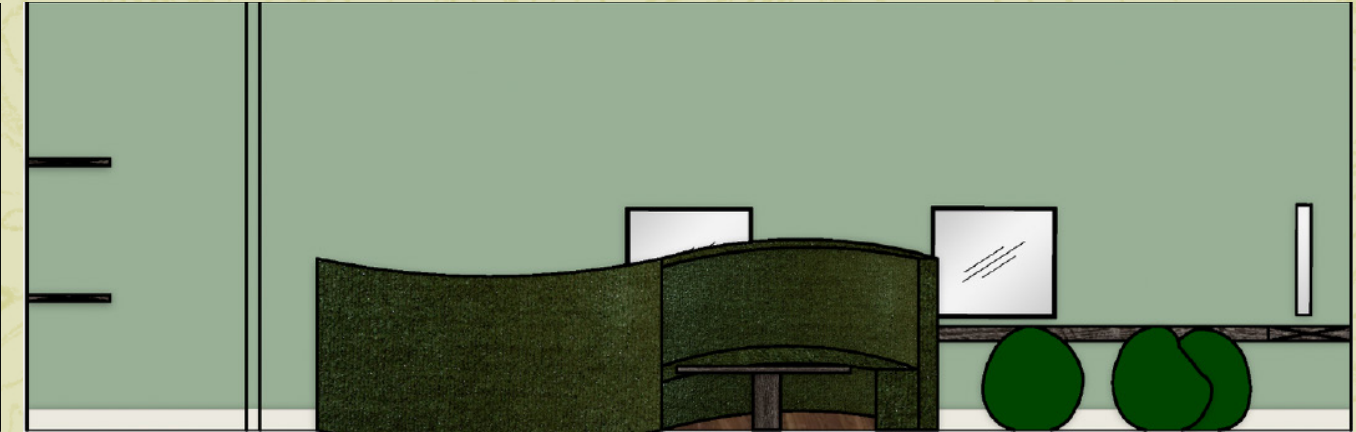
Final Floor Plan - Design Option 1

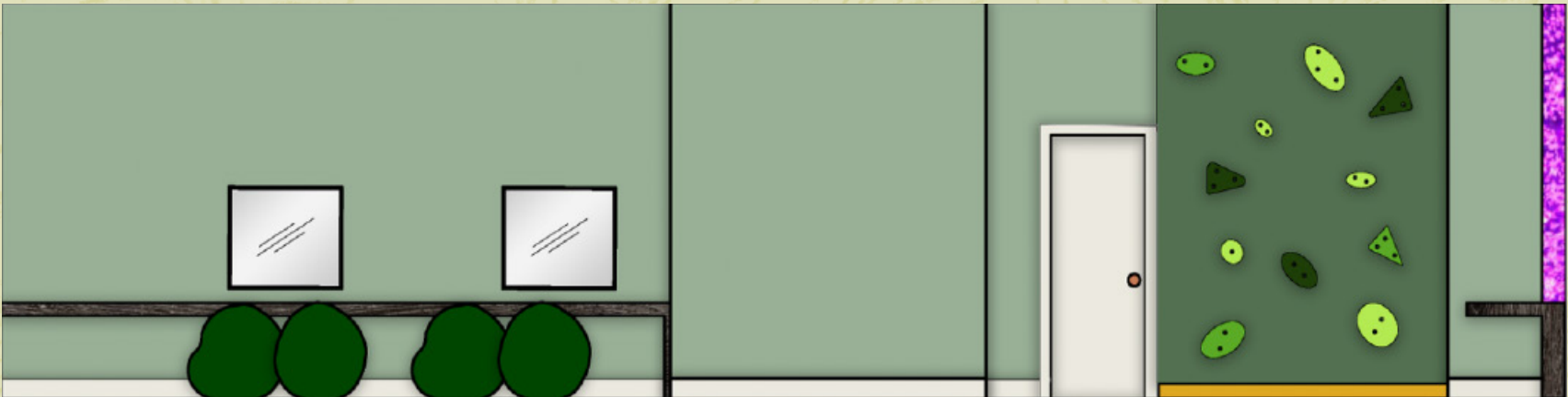

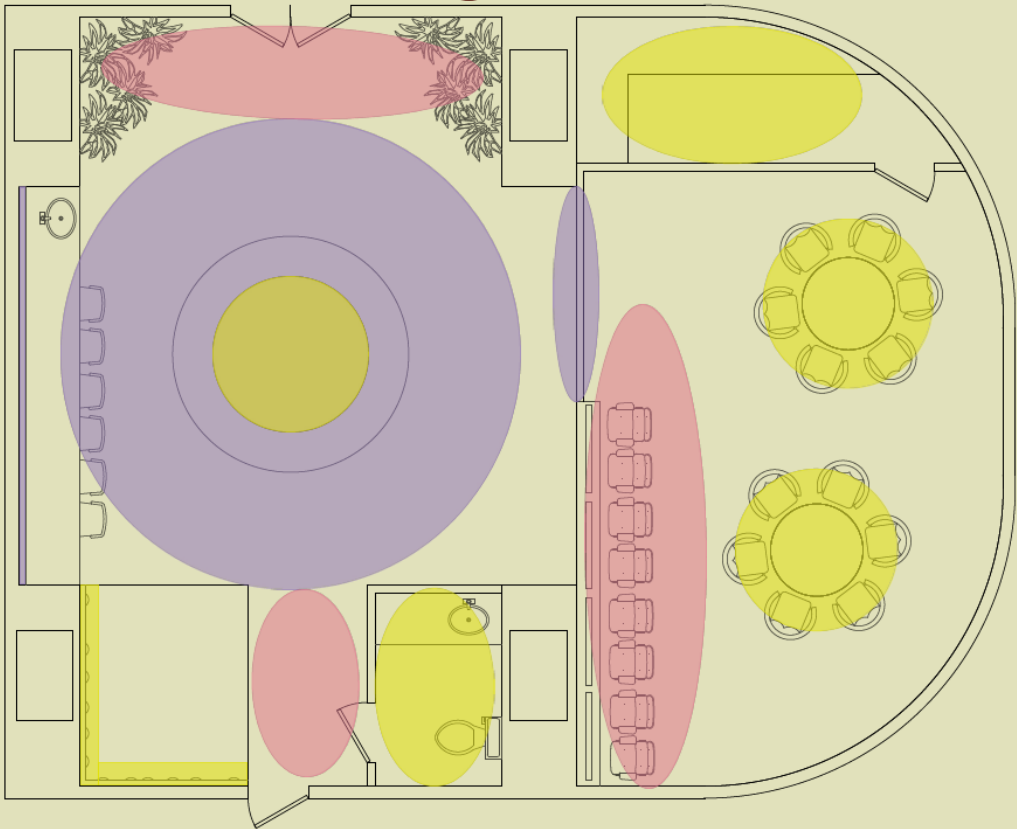

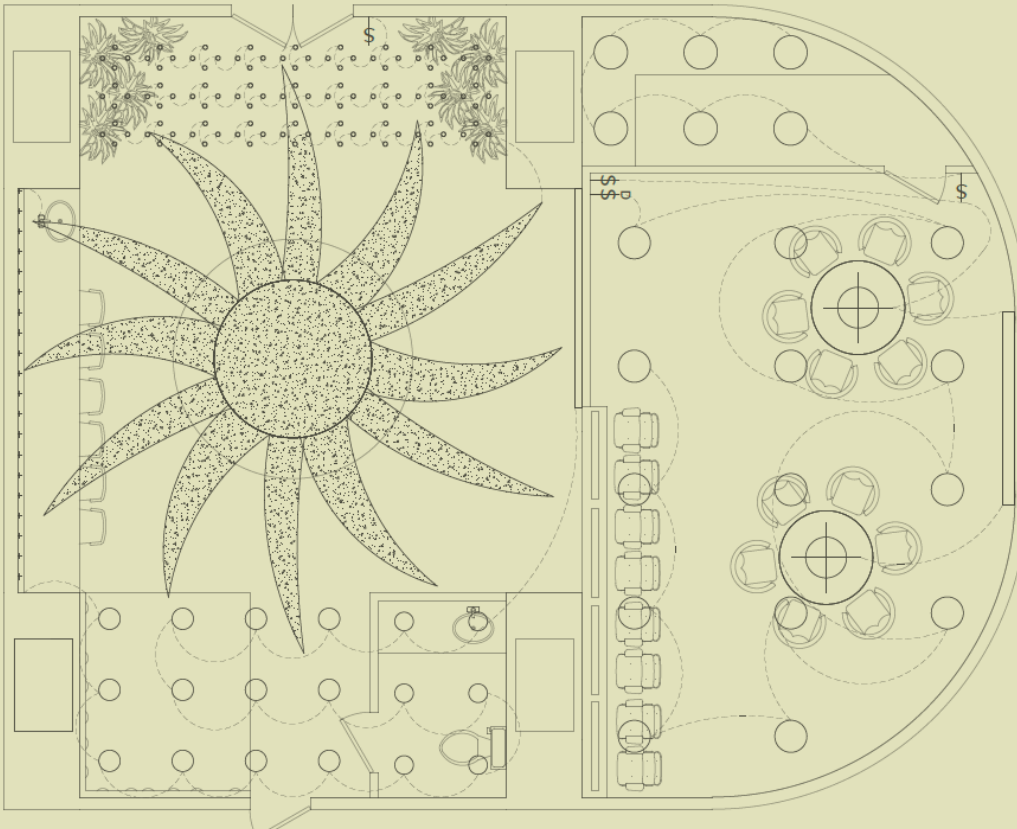

Inspired by childhood story books, I created a space where children could be transported into their favourite fairy stories. They can play at toadstool tables and read books from a glowing tree.

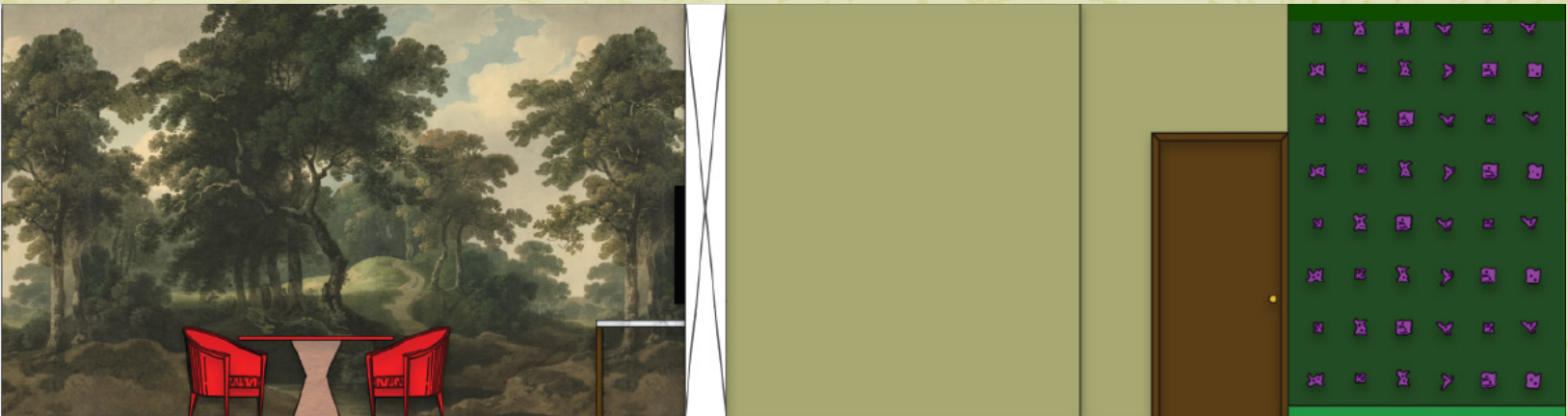

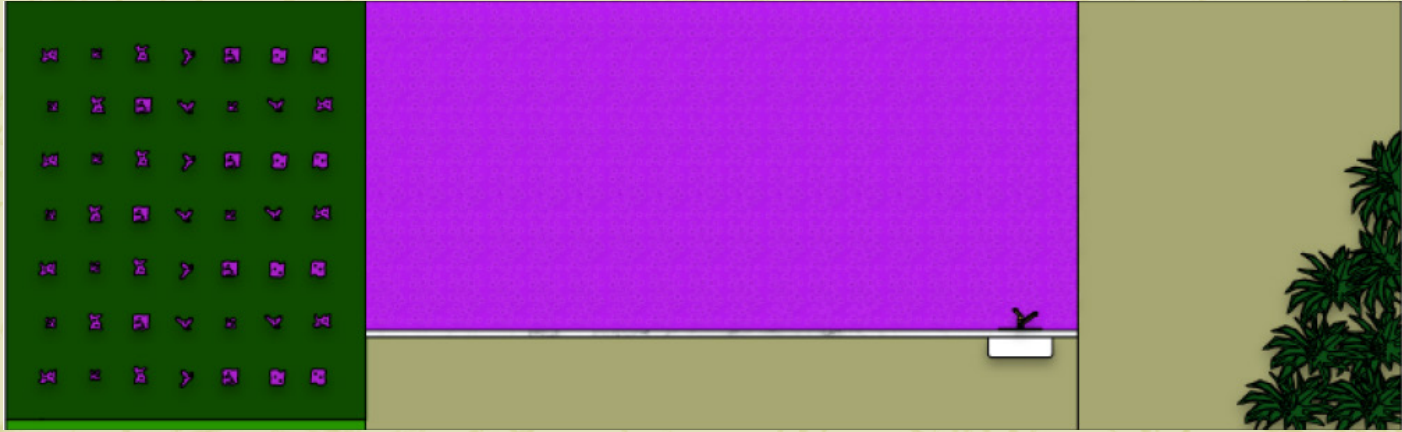

Design Comparison

Design Option 1 - Dinosaur Exploration



Pros

- An immersive learning experience
- Allows children to move around
- Older children can still enjoy the theme
- Seating for video games is spaced out

Cons

- Could be messy
- Games area is quite small
- Would require more supervision

Design Option 2 - Woodland



Pros

- Encourages reading for children
- Games and Video Games are kept separate so they can be a calmer experience
- The light feature covers a greater portion of the room
- Entrance Doors go inwards for more dramatic effect

Cons

- Less adventurous activities
- The theme might not be as interesting for older children
- Lots of space that could be filled with activities

Final Selection

Option 1 - The Dinosaur themed room is the better option as it accomodates a wider range of age and ability children. It has separate areas that would be fitting to either older or younger children and the activity areas are divided into high energy activities and low energy activities.

I prefer the open floor plan of the Dinosaur design as it allows children to be supervised more easily. It also helps children to see all of their options and so they aren't crowded in one area simply because they haven't seen the rest of the activities on offer.
