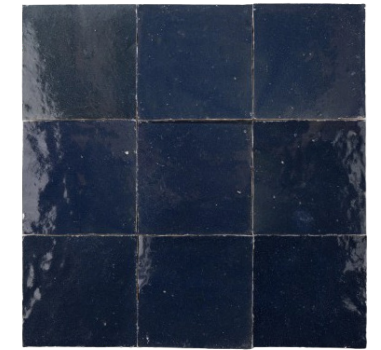
Planned and rendered purely in SketchUp, this remodel embraces eclectic creativity and concentrated style. Designed as a digital study in spatial rhythm and mid-century aesthetics, the home features continuous clerestory windows that bathe the interiors in natural light while preserving privacy and vertical warmth. A sunken conversation pit anchors the living area, while round beds and a custom-built bookcase add character-driven charm. Subtle elevation shifts throughout the floor plan distinguish room functions without sacrificing openness. Every element was arranged with intention, showcasing a balance of experimentation and spatial logic.

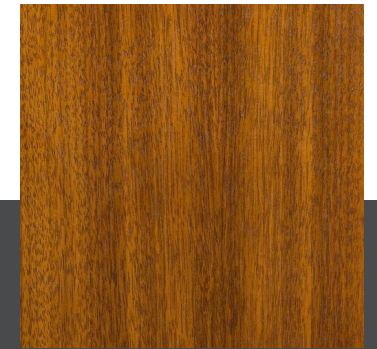


The Kitchen

The design here prioritizes rhythm, repetition, and visual grounding. Deep counters and tiled surfaces speak to durability, while clerestory glazing wraps the space in warmth and natural light. Open shelving and integrated storage offer practicality without sacrificing visual clarity, making the kitchen both a workspace and a lived-in showpiece.

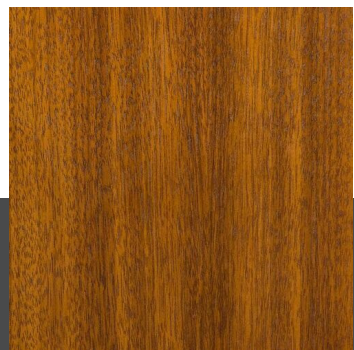

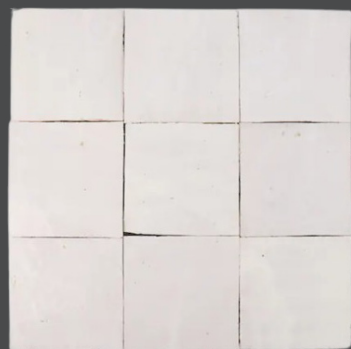

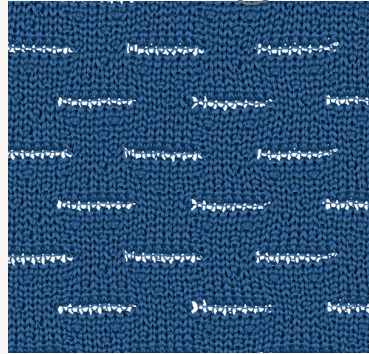
The Greenhouse

The greenhouse anchors the home in natural process and self-sufficiency. Framed in full glazing, the space invites morning light and plant life into the daily rhythm. Multiple vertical growing walls maximize yield in minimal footprint, while a full-height glass wall opens the view into the living room, connecting the greenhouse to the home's social heart.

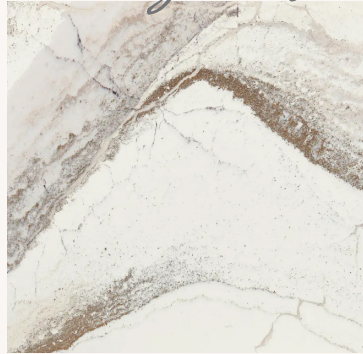

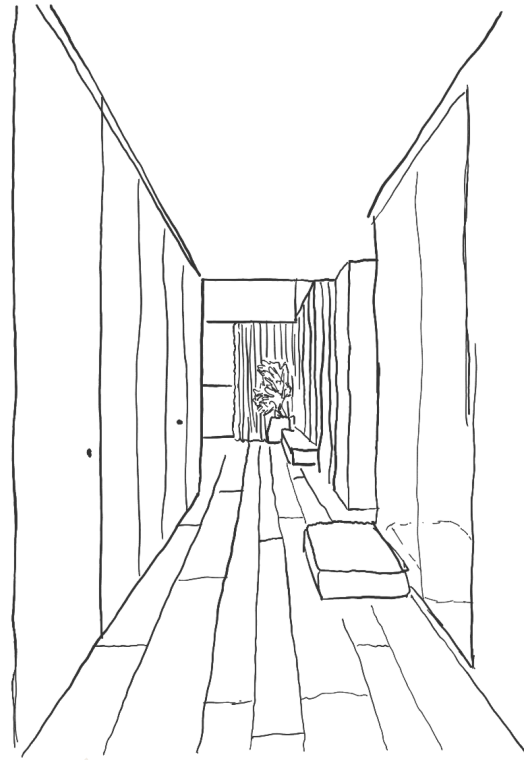
ome to the Headquarters Facilities department—those who oversee every detail of Temple Square—this 7th floor remodel is designed as both a functional pilot and a spiritual gesture. Drawing inspiration from Christ as the Good Shepherd, the space subtly mirrors pastoral calm: soft, wool-like textiles evoke the comfort of a flock gathered in safety, while deep blues reflect both the Church's identity and a sense of sacred stillness. The updated floor plan supports hybrid work through collaborative zones, improved storage, and flexible workspaces—all while honoring the architectural dignity of the Church Office Building. Here, form follows faith, creating an environment where stewardship, reverence, and purpose meet.



layout mirrors the mountains to the north of the site - louder, collaboration in the south valley, closed off offices near the northern peak



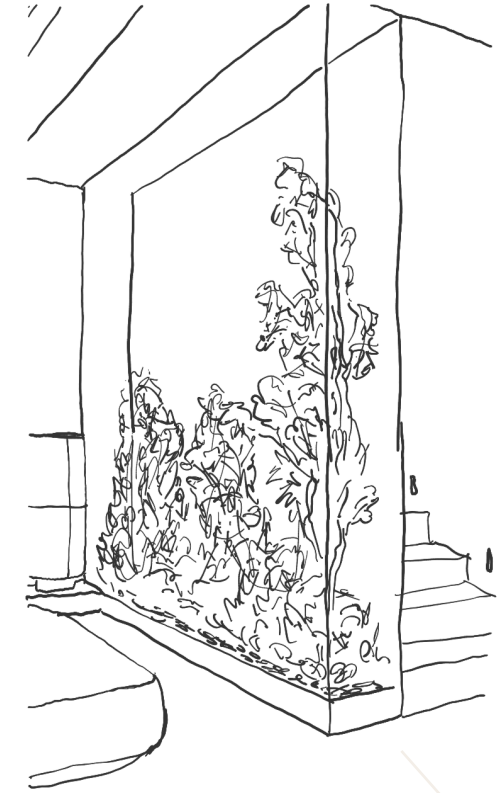

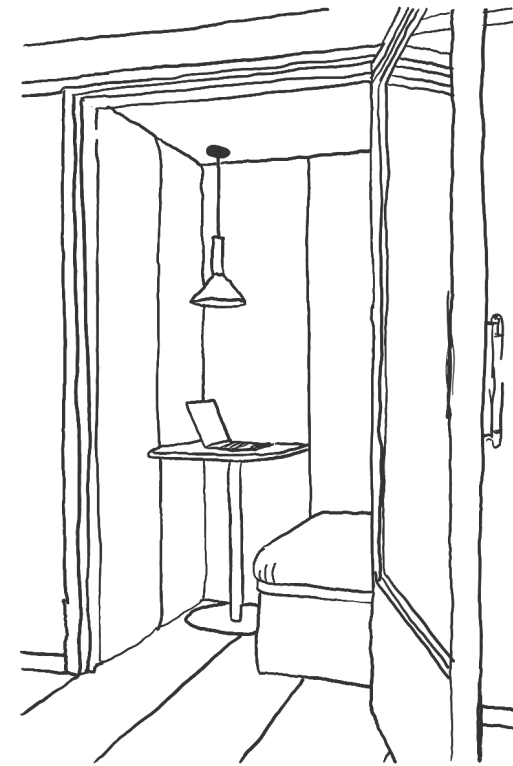

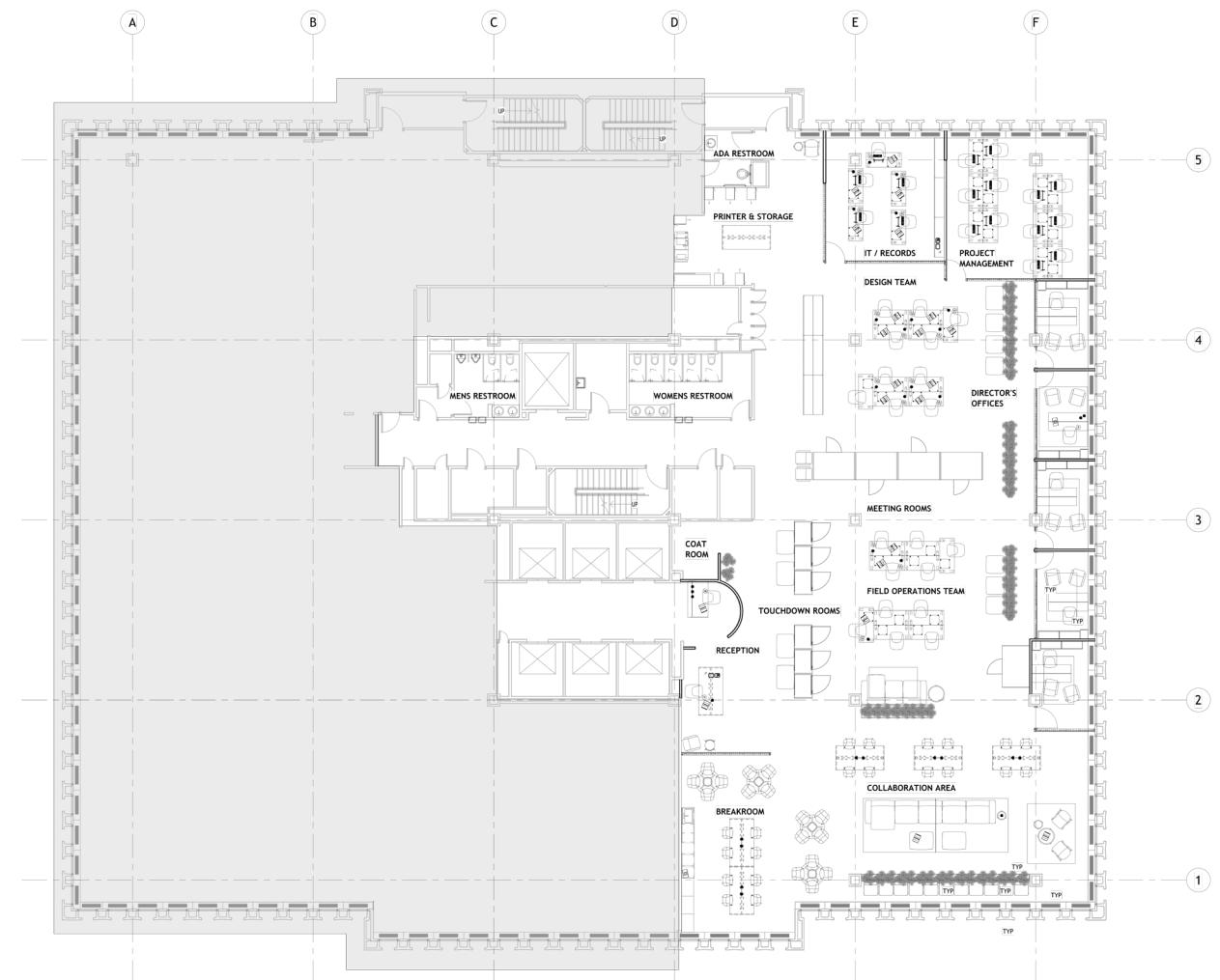
